Heaton Sports Club believes that it is important that members, coaches, administrators and parents, carers or guardians associated with the club should, at all times, show respect and understanding for the safety and welfare of others.

Therefore, it is encouraged to be open at all times and to share any concerns or complaints that they may have about any aspect of the club with the Club Safeguarding Officer.

As a member of Heaton Sports Club you are expected to abide by this policy

- Children are allowed to **enter and remain on the premises until 8.00pm** [during the weekend period] and must be accompanied by a parent/guardian or responsible adult;
- The Steward and/or representative member of bar staff has the right to ask an adult and/or child[ren] to leave should they see fit to do so;
- It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian and or responsible adult to ensure that their child/children are well behaved at all times and do not disrupt other people or have disregard for the club property;
- All members must respect the rights, dignity and worth of all regardless of gender, ability, cultural background or religion;
- Children are not allowed to consume alcohol or drugs of any kind on the club premises or whilst representing the club.
